As a planning team, one of our strategies is to present an **introduction portfolio** with the basic framework of what this year will look like, as well as inviting all area Pastors, with their ‘head’ Children’s and Youth Directors, to a scheduled ‘CVBS Coffee Chat’ at NBBI on Sunday FEBRUARY 23, 2025. This will be a time of initiating connection, communication and conversation about the direction and needs of the program.

# 2025 Program

This year we are working with with Answers In Genesis VBS program. We are proposing the dates of **Sunday June 22–Thursday June 26** from 6-8:30pm for ages 3-12.

Day 1: The baby King's birth was a wonder. What amazing happenings surrounded it?

Day 2: The young King's childhood was a wonder. What was he like as a child and teen?

Day 5: The return of the King of kings will be a wonder. What should we be doing in the meantime?

## Insurance Structure for this Event

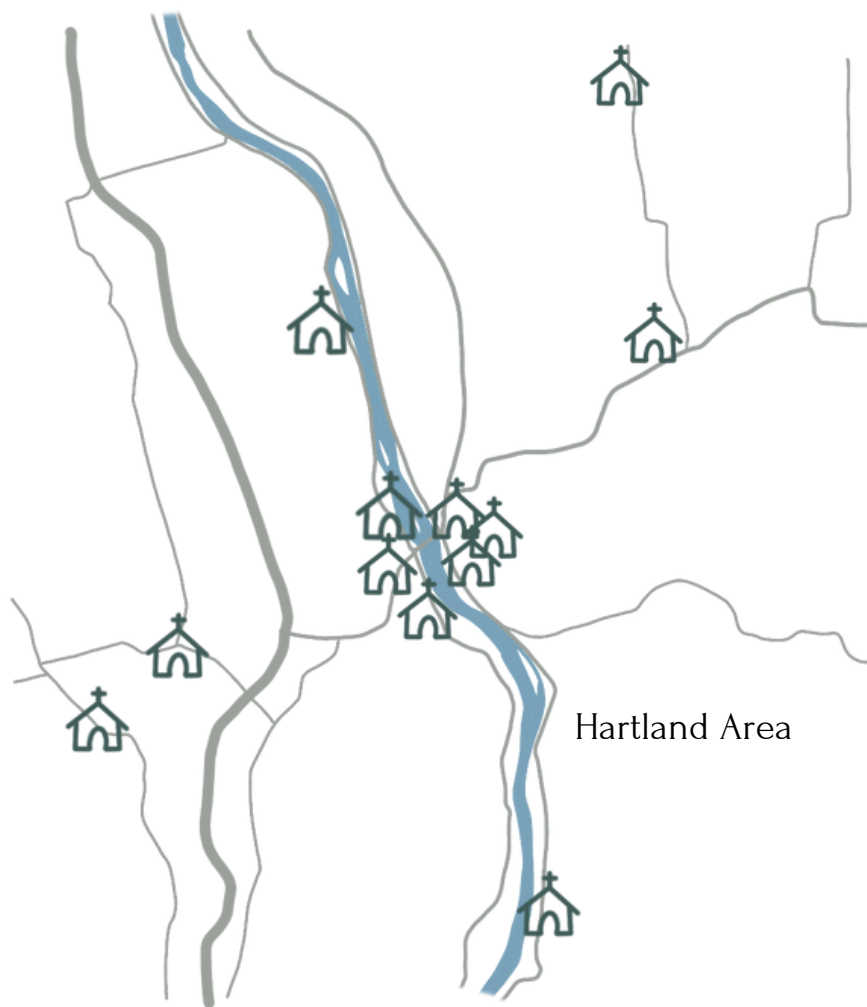
After consulting with Tina Belyea of Gallagher Insurance the following information was given:

1. Each Church participating needs to provide their own Certificate of Insurance
2. Each Church participating with its volunteers, will operate under its own liability insurance number (Church membership is not necessary)
3. Each Church needs to be aware that upon a claim, each church could potentially be called in, regardless of their individual liability in a given event
4. All Volunteers need to have an up to date Criminal Record Check & Vulnerable Sector Check, within the last 3-5 years (they should be screened by their own church)
5. Proper orientation, safety, first aid training & supervision must be observed at all times

These instructions & guidelines will serve as protocol, and we are asking for the full cooperation of each church in this area.



# Target Area of Reach



## Child Protection & Training

As a Planning Team, we are responsible for the organizing and administering the legal aspects of the CVBS 2025 Program. An event such as CVBS, operates under its own CVBS Child Protection Policy, while relying on the workers from participating churches to be up to date with their own; training, Background & Vulnerable sector checks.

ASAP - we will be initiating the process of requesting the required documentation, looking for lists of volunteers who are interested, and ensuring that the CVBS Child Protection Policy has met all requirements.

In the case of unsatisfactory documentation, or absence of training, the CVBS Planning Team will provide: a 'Background Reference Letter' for the acquisition of the Background check & Vulnerable Sector Check, as well as an online training link which MUST be completed prior to serving.



# Financial & Budget Communications

Two years ago the CVBS program was a 'pilot' project, operating at a location that was not central to our target area, and without concrete financial commitments from participating churches. With the nature of the project, the 2023 CVBS Planning Team set its budget at \$2500.00 to cover the costs of the program. The total cost for running the program was \$2,626.93, without including all the receipts that were not submitted by workers and leaders.

Last year in 2024 our location at NBBI provided a more central location with higher numbers in attendance and more participation from area churches. The 2024 CVBS budget was set by the Planning Team at \$3500.00. The total cost for running the program was \$2,200.00 not including snacks, decoration supplies and craft supplies.

This year for 2025 we will be using NBBI again as our central location for this ministry. The 2025 CVBS budget has been set by the Planning Team at \$3500.00. We are praying that our Local Churches will see the need for this outreach, and be moved to partner with us financially in this endeavour. We are seeking assistance of \$500.00 per church to help cover the costs of this years CVBS.



# 'Fielding A COMMUNITY TEAM for CVBS'

The CVBS Planning Team recognizes how dependent this Project must be on Prayer and Christ's leading. We are asking every church to represent this endeavour during their corporate midweek Prayer Meetings, as well as personally before the Throne of Grace. The CVBS Planning team is committing to sending out regular 'Calendar updates' with prayer requests and information.

## FIELDING THE TEAM:

- Following the March 17 information meeting - CVBS Ambassadors will be selected
- The CVBS Project will be running 2 Programs at once: VBS 5-12 & Toddler VBS
- This will require 50-60 Team Leaders & Workers (Not all positions are 'hands on')
- There will be Department Coordinators that will then be appointed from the churches:
  - Bible Teaching
  - Music & Opening Director
  - Snacks
  - Games
  - Crafts
  - Decorating
  - Set UP & Clean UP
  - Audio & Video Services
  - Nursing & First Aid
  - Welcome & Sign In (Connecting Parents with Christians & churches in the Community)
    - These will be responsible for the structure of their Department & 'Field it'
    - These Departments are open for everyone from other churches to join
    - Communication 'across the board' will be key to success

# What is the Gospel?

While not exhaustive, our desire is to proclaim God's Gospel as the Old Testament & New Testament Scriptures present, according to the teaching of King Jesus, and His 'Ambassadors with full authority' who were the apostles.

Teaching Definition of the Person of Christ:

The Person of Jesus is fully God and 'sinless humanity', two natures in perfect harmony & distinction without confusion, divinely unified in one body, and will be so forever as God's begotten King over Humanity & Creation. (Luke 1:31-33; Eph 1:18- 23...Phil. 2:5-11...I Cor. 15:24-28...Rev. 22:3)

I Corinthians 15 establishes the 'Foundation of the Gospel' to the NT Church:

Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, 2 by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you— unless you believed in vain.

1. Paul is going to layout the Gospel of God again for this Church of Corinth.
2. They had received the affirmation of the Gospel through their own 1st Century prophets & teachers.
3. The Church would be held accountable for their obedience to the Gospel at the Judgment seat of Christ.
4. If these believers were complacent with the Gospel – they would NOT be saved from the consequences.
  - a. Daniel 12:1-4; Rom. 14; I Cor. 3; II Cor. 5

God's Gospel -

3 For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received:

· that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,

·

4 and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,

·

5 and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve. 6 After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. 7 After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. 8 Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.

9 For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. 10 But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.

11 Therefore, whether it was I or they, so we preach and so you believed.



With very little of the NT Written – The Jewish Paul begins the Gospel of Christ as follows:

1. The 'Christos' – Anointed Chosen One – Seed of David, Son of David, Son of God, King of Israel:

a. Davidic Covenant -

"He shall build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom

forever. 14 I will be his Father, and he shall be My son." II Sam. 7:13-14

i. "He first found his own brother Simon, and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which is translated, the Christ)." Jn 1:41

ii. "We have found Him of whom Moses in the law, and also the prophets, wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." Jn 1:45

iii. "Rabbi, You are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!" Jn 1:49

2. The 'Anointed Chosen One' – God's Son – God's King died for our sins according to the Scriptures:

a. Sin before God has ALWAYS required a blood sacrifice – (Romans 3:23; Heb. 9:22) All have sinned.

b. "See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil..." Dt. 30:15 - 'For the wages of sin is death'

c. The Lamb of God – sinless sacrifice – 'peace offering' for Position & Fellowship before God's coming justice.

d. Gen. 22; Lev. 4:26; Ex. 12; Ps. 2; 16; 22; Isaiah 53; Dan. 9

3. The 'Anointed Chosen One' was buried & rose again according to the Scriptures:

a. Ps. 16:8-10; 110; Is. 53:10-12; Ezek. 36-37

4. The 'Anointed Chosen One' was seen alive!! Fulfilling OT Prophecy & God's Predestinated Plan.

5. The 'Anointed Chosen One' will raise those who are His -to their inheritance in His Messianic Kingdom

22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. 23 But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming. 24 Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. 25 For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet. 26 The last enemy that will be destroyed is death.

6. The 'Anointed Chosen One' – all believers will be like Him in glorified form: We shall be changed.

51 Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed—52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. [See Daniel 12:1-4 for 'Accountability']

7. The 'Anointed Chosen One'- 'Make things right' with inheritance, wage & reward, ruling position in Kingdom.

58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord. [See Is. 53:11-12; Rom. 14; I Cor. 3; II Cor. 5]

What is the Biblical Gospel HOPE – Short form?

Christ is God's King

God's King died for ALL sins

God raised His King from the dead

God's King is ALIVE @ His right hand

God's King is coming again with EARTHLY Kingdom

God's King will judge the living & the dead

God's King will RESTORE ALL Things.
